Welcome to an unforgettable adventure with the Canadian Fossil Discovery Centre (CFDC). The CFDC is dedicated to educating and challenging the minds and imaginations of individuals. We invite you to join us in exploring the geological and paleontological history of Southern Manitoba.

Your Fossil Dig Adventure Tour begins at the CFDC as you learn about the prehistoric geography of southern Manitoba and the wondrous life that existed here. The tour features "Bruce", a 13m (43ft) Mosasaur and Guinness World Record Holder™, and other marine creatures of the Late Cretaceous Seas – from plesiosaurs to ammonites and sharks, including rock types and their roles with fossils. You will learn about fossil collecting techniques, fossil identification and have the opportunity to learn first-hand about fossil preparation using the tools of the trade. Then enjoy a complimentary lunch with the staff courtesy of the CFDC.

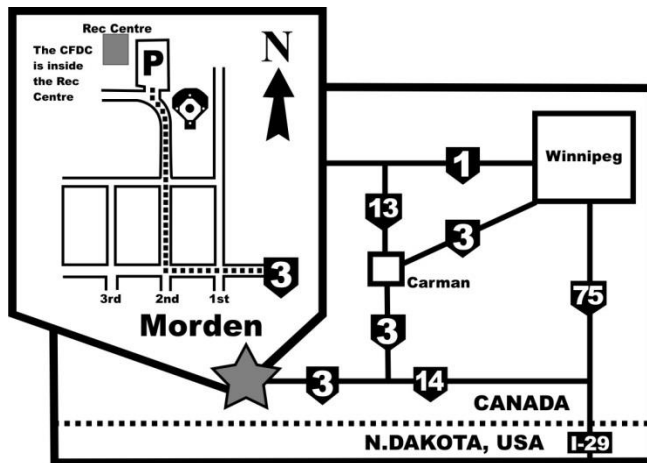
You will be taken to our dig site, a 20-30 minute drive from the Centre on the Manitoba Escarpment, where you will have the opportunity to explore and excavate an 80 million year old sea floor. This will include a discussion on rock and mineral formation, the use of tools and the history of the dig site.

Feel free to bring in any fossil or rock you've always wanted identified.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- **Available May 1 to October 31 weather permitting.**
- **All participants must sign liability waiver forms.**
- Participants must be 10 years of age or over
- Recommended minimum of 4 people. Smaller groups may be combined with others.
- Included in the 1 Day Fossil Dig Adventure Tour program:
 - A Guided Museum Tour of the CFDC
 - Fossil Preparation
 - Lunch (provided)
 - Transportation to and from dig site
 - Snacks and beverages at the dig site
 - An afternoon of excavating (tools and equipment will be supplied)
- All participants are to meet at the CFDC. Once here, our team will go over the program's itinerary as well as a few ground rules and regulations. Allergy and dietary information should be provided with registration.
- We ask that you respect the arrival time scheduled for your tour.
- All participants must wear appropriate clothing and footwear (**NO** sandals). **Appropriate footwear is a must...** you will be hiking on ground upon which sure footing is required.

- A hat, sunscreen, insect repellent, water-bottle, and either a towel or knee-pads are recommended.
- It is important to emphasize that any fossils found at the site (and according to our curator, there are lots out there!) **MUST REMAIN AT THE SITE**. We are regimented by laws in regards to our digs and it is imperative that we follow these regulations.
- **A non-refundable deposit of 50% of total tour cost is required** with your registration. The remainder is payable on the day of, but prior to beginning, your tour. Deposit is refunded only when tour is cancelled due to weather.
- If it is necessary for you to cancel your booking, we ask that you inform us as soon as possible.
- Our gift shop will be open and offers a wide variety of souvenirs, books, toys, rocks and fossils.
